

Cash & Cash Deposit Form

- ◆ Do not commingle personal and Foundation funds
- Submit cash to Treasurer immediately after collection

Check Request Form - PREFERRED!!!

- ◆ Attach Invoice
- Two authorized signatures required



Expense Reimbursement Form

- Original Receipts Preferred, not invoice
- Person requesting reimbursement cannot also be an authorized signer
- Submit within 30 days

Acceptable Signatures

- Digital ID
- ♦ Wet Signature
- Email confirmation Copy all signers, reply-all "Approved"

*Principal's Signature Required for Requests of \$5,000 or more.

Annual Contribution Statements

Charitable Gaming: Raffle & Bingo

PPS PARENT FUND AWARDS fundforpps.org/ppsparentfund

As you know, PPS has a policy that requires LSFs to share one-third of the funding that they raise for staffing.

- The first \$10,000 that is raised is exempt.
- Funds raised above \$10,000 are split with one-third going into the PPS
 Parent Fund and two-thirds staying with the school that raised the funds.

Schools with 15% or more students qualified for free meals receive a PPS Parent Fund Award. The size of their award is based on the number of students who are underserved. School Principals propose how they will use the funds towards their school improvement goals. Typcial expenditures include: increasing hours of a part-time staff person (e.g. office staff, EA), family engagement, student supports and activities.

In 2023-24, 62 schools and programs were awarded \$1,168,000.

FLOW OF FUNDS

Timeline - School/Fiscal Year

Funds raised in the current fiscal year are available for principal's to use for staffing the following school year.

➤ Funds raised in 2023-24 will be available for Principals to use in 2024-25.

The Fund for PPS holds and tracks funds from July 1 - June 30 each year.

After June 30th, all funds are transferred to Portland Public Schools.

All Local School Foundations begin with a \$0 balance on July 1st.
