PPS Parent Fund Awards are made possible by the fundraising contributions of PPS Local School Foundations. To qualify for an award, schools and programs had to have 15% or greater students who qualify for Free Meals by Direct Certification. The size of the grant award is based on a school or program's number of students designated as Combined Underserved.

Terms Defined:

Free Meals by Direct Certification

Direct Certification status is determined by state agencies and shared electronically with school districts. Students or families qualify for Direct Certification through a number of avenues such as eligibility for SNAP or TANF, Migrant Ed, or foster care. Free Meal by Direct Certification % is the percent of total students who receive free meals through Direct Certification. This is the only free meal data that is comparable across all schools.

Combined Underserved

Combined Underserved includes the following: Students eligible for Special Education; Students with Limited English Proficiency; Students eligible to receive free meals by Direct Certification; Students with any of the following races, ethnicities, or ancestry: Black, Latino/Hispanic, Native American, Pacific Islander.

Projected Enrollment

Student enrollment numbers are calculated based on enrollment as of October 1, 2022, and projected based on which schools the students will matriculate to for 2023-24.
